The wine has a straw-yellow color with golden reflections. It features fragrant aromas of white flowers and fresh fruit, with savory minerality and a dry finish.

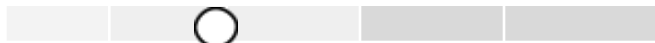
