The Emilia Wine Group is a wine-growing cooperative located in the Reggio Emilia region. This cooperative works together to produce enjoyable wines that strike a balance between tradition and modernity. The geographical characteristics of Emilia make it an ideal area for vine cultivation. The cooperative manages 1,500 hectares of vineyards that extend across a diverse landscape, ranging from plains to hillsides. In the cooler, clay-rich plains, Lambrusco grapes are cultivated.

### Tasting Notes

A pleasantly fruity nose with subtle aromas of raspberry and ripe red berries. This wine is medium-bodied, exhibiting a sweetness balanced by its refreshing acidity.
